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Guidelines for teachers about oral questions. (Total Marks 10)

Oral Q. 1 : Listen to the passage and answer the questions (Oral).

Instructions for teacher :

- Read the passage considering proper pace in which child may understand it.
- Each child should be dealt in independently.
- If the number of children is big, then oral assessment may be spread over 2-3 days.

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Oral Q. 2 : Passage for reading.

(5 Marks)

Ask the child to read the following passage aloud.

Instructions for examiner :

- This question is to test child's reading skill as well as understanding.
- Each child should be dealt in independently.
- If the number of children is big, then oral assessment may be spread over 2-3 days.

Passage :

A lion was sleeping. A mouse was playing nearby. The lion caught the mouse. "Let me go, please. I shall help you" said the mouse. "I am big. You are so small. You cannot help me. But go away." The lion was caught in a net. It roared. The little mouse came. It nibbled at the ropes. The lion was free.

Allotment of marks for reading :

Marks	Criteria
5	Loud reading with proper stress and intonation. Speed/pace of reading is not important. Re-reading of sentences is permissible.
4	Could read some sentences with proper stress and intonation.
3	Attempts to read with efforts. Reads sensibly.
2	Able to read without guidance but no sensible reading.
1	Could read few words after provided help but clarity and sensible reading is missing.
0	Child didn't show any interest in reading. Though provided help couldn't read.
