She decided to take flying lessons and worked hard to learn everything about flying. On 22 October 1922. She flew to a height of 14,000 feet and set a world record for female pilots. On 15 May 1923, Amelia Earhart became the sixteenth woman to be issued a pilot's licence. She became the first woman passenger to cross the Atlantic in 1928. In May 1932, she crossed the Atlantic alone and set a new record. Her last flight was in July 1937 when she mysteriously disappeared while trying to fly around the world. Amelia's husband published her biography entitled 'Soaring Wings' in her memory in 1939.
